



SMARTSCAPE RENOVATION REBATE

The SmartScape Renovation Program encourages residential water customers to convert healthy, water-thirsty plant material into water wise landscapes. Applications are processed in the order received and distributed on a first-come, first-served basis. Minimum rebate is 250 sq.ft; maximum rebate is \$1,500 per account. THIS FORM IS FOR RESIDENTIAL CUSTOMERS ONLY.

Upon approval of this application, the Town of Castle Rock has the right and license to use my name, image, likeness, and comments in Castle Rock materials for internal and external audiences. Requirements and Other Information

The Smartscape Renovation Program encourages residential water customers to convert water thirsty plant materials into water wise landscapes.

- In order to be eligible, all renovations must be completed with the current program year.
- Applications submitted after landscape work has begun and without an initial site inspection may not be approved.
- An initial site inspection will be scheduled with you by the Program Administrator.
- Sprinklers in renovated area must be removed or redesigned to appropriately water new xeriscape.
- Xeriscape must be watered separately from turf grass.
- All expenses are out-of-pocket to the applicant.

- A completed project is defined as:
 - Installation completed according to submitted plan, including authorized changes.
 - Area should be covered with 4" of wood mulch or 2" of rock mulch.
 - Edging must be securely buried in the soil and/or mulch. Edge must be rolled or capped.
 - Project and surrounding area will be weed free and sidewalks will be clear of debris. Any fabric used should not be showing.
- Project must be complete and final inspection must be scheduled by September 30 of the program year.
- Failure to comply with any requirement of this program may result in denial of rebate.

Water Budget

- Smartscape renovations will result in changes to the irrigable area used to calculate the monthly water budget for this property. A water budget adjustment application must be submitted prior to project completion. The adjustment form will be provided by the Program Administrator.

AFFIDAVIT OF LAWFUL PRESENCE IN THE U.S.

- a valid Colorado driver's license;
Note: The Colorado Department of Revenue will allow us to accept a driver's license from the District of Columbia or any of the following 33 states: Alabama, Arizona, Arkansas, California, Connecticut, Delaware, Florida, Georgia, Idaho, Indiana, Iowa, Kansas, Kentucky, Louisiana, Maine, Minnesota, Mississippi, Missouri, Montana, Nevada, New Hampshire, New Jersey, New York, North Dakota, Ohio, Oklahoma, Pennsylvania, Rhode Island, South Carolina, South Dakota, Virginia, West Virginia, or Wyoming;
- a valid Colorado identification card;
- a United States military card;
- a United States military dependent's identification card;
- a United States Coast Guard Merchant Mariner card;
- a Native American tribal document;
- a birth certificate issued by a state, county or parish;
- a naturalization or citizenship certificate;
- a court-issued adoption order
- an unexpired foreign passport
- an I-94 immigration form with refugee or asylum status; or
- an unexpired resident alien card, permanent resident card, temporary resident card, or employment authorization card.

In addition, you must sign an affidavit stating either: (1) you are a United States citizen; or (2) you are a legal permanent resident of the United States; or (3) you are otherwise lawfully present in the United States pursuant to federal law. A blank affidavit is attached for your convenience.

Please mail a photocopy of your identification (in one of the forms listed above) and your signed affidavit along with the other rebate paperwork.
