



## SMART IRRIGATION CONTROLLER REBATE

The Smart Controller rebate encourages residents to upgrade their old controllers with new weather-based or soil moisture-based technology. These state-of-the-art irrigation controllers, called Smart, ET, or evapotranspiration controllers, can conserve water, save money and reduce runoff by automating landscape watering based on the weather and water needs of the plants.

### Requirements and Other Information

1. This rebate is intended to replace or upgrade the old controller with new, weather-based technology.
2. Applications are processed in the order received and rebates are distributed on a first-come, first-served basis. Funding is limited.
3. Rebate will reimburse participant for 50% of the purchase price of the new smart irrigation controller (excluding installation costs, taxes and shipping/handling) up to a maximum of \$300 (non-residential maximum is five controllers).
4. All expenses are out-of-pocket to the applicant.
5. Participants are limited to one rebate per account.
6. Smart irrigation controller must be new and meet qualifying criteria.
7. Smart irrigation controller must be purchased and installed at the water account address, in the Town of Castle Rock Water service area, during the current rebate year.
8. Rebate checks are issued within three (3) to six (6) weeks after completion of application, required supplemental information, and the old controller has been brought to Castle Rock Water for recycling.
9. Actual water savings may vary.
10. Upon approval of this application, the Town of Castle Rock has the right and license to use my image, likeness, and comments in Castle Rock materials for internal and external audiences. These materials include, but are not limited to, advertisements, brochures, new releases, magazines, newspapers, newsletters, videos, and presentations.
11. Attach a copy of the original sales receipt to this application.
12. A signed copy of the Affidavit of Lawful Presence, along with an acceptable form of identification are required.
13. **To be eligible for this rebate, the Town requires that you bring the old controller that was replaced to Castle Rock Water, 175 Kellogg Ct., Castle Rock, CO 80109. The old controller will be recycled by the Town of Castle Rock.**

Submittal of the on-line application is not considered complete until the acknowledgement and affidavit are signed by the applicant and the old controller has been brought to Castle Rock Water for recycling.

**AFFIDAVIT OF LAWFUL PRESENCE IN THE U.S.**

*(Required for Town of Castle Rock Rebate Applications)*

I understand that this sworn statement is required by law because I have applied for a public benefit. I understand that state law requires me to provide proof that I am lawfully present in the United States prior to receipt of this public benefit. I further acknowledge that making a false, fictitious or fraudulent statement or representation in this sworn affidavit is punishable under the criminal laws of Colorado as perjury in the second degree under Colorado Revised Statute 18-8-503 and it shall constitute a separate criminal offense each time a public benefit is fraudulently received.

*Note: The Colorado Department of Revenue will allow us to accept a driver's license from the District of Columbia or any of the following 33 states: Alabama, Arizona, Arkansas, California, Connecticut, Delaware, Florida, Georgia, Idaho, Indiana, Iowa, Kansas, Kentucky, Louisiana, Maine, Minnesota, Mississippi, Missouri, Montana, Nevada, New Hampshire, New Jersey, New York, North Dakota, Ohio, Oklahoma, Pennsylvania, Rhode Island, South Carolina, South Dakota, Virginia, West Virginia, or Wyoming;*
- *a valid Colorado identification card;*
- *a United States military card;*
- *a United States military dependent's identification card;*
- *a United States Coast Guard Merchant Mariner card;*
- *a Native American tribal document;*
- *a birth certificate issued by a state, county or parish;*
- *a naturalization or citizenship certificate;*
- *a court-issued adoption order*
- *an unexpired foreign passport*
- *an I-94 immigration form with refugee or asylum status; or*
- *an unexpired resident alien card, permanent resident card, temporary resident card, or employment authorization card.*

*In addition, you must sign an affidavit stating either: (1) you are a United States citizen; or (2) you are a legal permanent resident of the United States; or (3) you are otherwise lawfully present in the United States pursuant to federal law. A blank affidavit is attached for your convenience.*

*Please mail a photocopy of your identification (in one of the forms listed above) and your signed affidavit along with the other rebate paperwork.*
